

Dear Parents and Band Students:

As the end of June draws near, it is once again time to begin thinking about marching season and the year to come. This letter is meant to provide band students and their parents with important information for the coming year. This year's band camp will be held at Schreiner College in Kerrville from August 2<sup>nd</sup>-6<sup>th</sup>. On August 5<sup>th</sup>, the band will display what it has worked on throughout the week to its proud Tiger parents and anyone else who wants to see the beginning of another great Dripping Springs marching season. This year's marching show, *Mood Rings*, is utilizing the music of Sergei Prokofiev. All students are required to have *Mood 1- March* memorized before we leave for camp. The final summer listening day is July 14<sup>th</sup> from 9:00-11:00am. Students that have not passed off by the beginning of practices will be required to stay from 12:30-2:30pm on July 28<sup>th</sup>-30<sup>th</sup>. Students that have passed off will not be required to attend the afternoon rehearsals on these days. One consideration for a marching spot is having your music memorized.

Students are required to have a physical form on file before practice begins on July 28<sup>th</sup>. These should be turned in at registration night. A physical form may be obtained at [www.dsbands.org](http://www.dsbands.org) for your convenience. Students that have not had a physical will not be allowed to practice. This could also be a factor in choosing marching spots for this year.

The band will be holding a registration night on **July 27<sup>th</sup>** at the high school band hall for all members. We are requiring that all students and at least one parent/guardian be present at this registration. Refer to the schedule on the back of this page to see when your class is to register. **Any student showing up without a parent will not be allowed to enter the registration process or sign up for a room for camp, this includes seniors.** Please make every effort to be at this meeting so we can take care of all payments and turn in all forms. You need at least one parent or legal guardian to attend so all paperwork can be filled out correctly. If you or one of your parents cannot attend this meeting you must let me know so other arrangements can be made. A detailed list of what you will pay for and do at registration is included in this letter. **Registration is not productive if you show up but are not prepared, so pay close attention to the list.**

Fees for band camp will be **\$175.00** per person this year. Families with two or more siblings will pay \$150.00 per person. This fee will pay for housing in the dorms and all meals. Meals will be in the college cafeteria on campus. All students will sign up for a band camp roommate during registration. Please decide with whom you would like to share a room prior to July 27<sup>th</sup>.

Students will again be given the opportunity to buy meals for away football games through the boosters. These meals will be delivered to the school prior to departure. Students will not be allowed to leave campus once school is dismissed so it is highly encouraged that you purchase the meals. Payment for band camp, game meals, sustenance fee, water jug, and booster membership will be paid to the ***Dripping Springs Band Boosters***. All other items purchased will be paid to ***DSHS Bands***. You will need two checks made out to two different organizations. Tax has already been included in the amounts listed in this letter. This caused confusion in the past. If any student or parent feels they cannot pay for band camp or any of the other fees please call the band hall and a payment plan will be worked out for you. We want all students to be a part of the band.

This year all students must use the booster water jug (\$8.00) at band camp, all rehearsals, and at all football games. No other water jugs will be allowed. Students will not be allowed to share water jugs for health reasons. Students that need a new water jug will purchase and pick them up at registration night.

Included with this letter is a schedule for band events for the year. Please read the schedule carefully and make arrangements to be at all events which are required. Rehearsals have been scheduled for three days before camp and several days after camp. The rehearsals, games, and contests are mandatory and all students are expected to attend. Included with this letter is a conflict form. The form must be filled out, signed and returned at registration. Directors will review the conflicts and use this information to help determine who gets permanent marching spots. Please take the time to carefully check your calendar and the band calendar so no surprises arise during the season.

**(1) MORE ON BACK**

The following is a short schedule of rehearsals before school starts and a list of items each student needs to bring with them to the registration night and band camp. Please help your son/daughter make sure they have everything listed so we will have an enjoyable and successful beginning of the year.

**Registration Night—July 27<sup>th</sup> Follow the time for your grade**

**The following are items to bring to registration night. If you do not have something please take care of getting it before July 27<sup>th</sup>.**

**Flip folder with at least 10 pages**-All Band (including percussion)

**3 Ring Binder with at least 10 clear plastic sheet protectors**-All Band (including percussion)

**Music lyre**—All wind players except tubas

**Permission slip and insurance card**—Please bring the permission slip that is included with this letter with you. Fill out all the information including the medical section. This is an important piece of paperwork that we must have to take you anywhere the band travels. This year we are asking for a current insurance card for each student. Bring your card with you to the registration and we will make a copy and return the original to you that night.

**Physical Form**—All students are required to have a physical form on file before practice on July 29<sup>th</sup>. If you have not turned your form in you will need to do so at registration.

**UIL Acknowledgement Form**—Form provided with this letter

**Conflict Sheet**—Form provided with this letter/Must be filled out and signed by student and PARENT.

**The following are items that need to be paid for the night of registration. Some of these items you will receive that night and others you will receive later in the season. Please decide what you need and be prepared to pay for these items that night.**

**Band camp fee/\$175.00**—This is the fee for band camp to pay for housing and meals. If a family has more than one sibling in the band the cost would be \$150.00 per person. Paid to Boosters.

**Meal Fee/5 meals/\$35.00**—This fee is for 1 meal that will be delivered before each away football game. Students will not be allowed to leave campus after school. If students do not purchase this plan they will have to bring a meal from home. The meal form is included with this information. Paid to Boosters.

**Stamp & Sustenance Fee/\$35.00**--This fee covers bottled water @ contests, sodas @ games, up to 4 contest meals. Paid to Boosters.

**Charter Bus Fee/\$70.00**—This fee is to charter buses for the Marching contests on October 2<sup>nd</sup> and 30<sup>th</sup>. We will leave early in the morning and return late. Students will be able to sleep and eat on these buses much easier than school buses. This fee is required for everyone. Paid to Band.

## Items for Band Students Only-Prices Already Include Tax

**Gloves/\$3.25**—Everyone in the band except percussionists and color guard will wear gloves. These are the same gloves as last year.

**T-shirt/\$13.00**—This is the show shirt that will have the contest show theme on it. This will be purchased by everyone in the band and worn during the season at pep rallies and marching contests. The shirts will be passed out shortly after school starts.

*Parents may purchase a Show T-shirt or Band or Guard Polo Shirt if they wish. Please let the person working at the station, of the item you wish to purchase, know that you are interested in buying an item. They will add your name to the list. You need to pay for whatever items you order that night. In addition, there will be a separate station for specific Band Booster Parent shirts. Several styles will be available for order with the Band Parent logo embroidered. Again, you will need to pay for whatever items you order that night.*

**Band Shoes/\$19.00 each pair (price for 2 pair=\$38.00)**—Every band member must have 2 pair of band shoes (1white/1 black) this year. These can only be ordered through the school. The salesman will be at a rehearsal in August to size students for the shoes. Anyone needing shoes will pay for them at registration.

**Cleaning Fee/\$48.00**—Each band uniform will be laundered a minimum of 4 times during the year. The cost for one cleaning of the uniform is \$12.00. If the uniforms must be cleaned more than 4 times an additional payment may be needed at the end of the year.

**Instrument Rental/\$60.00**—Students that play tuba, baritone, french horn, bari sax, bass clarinet, contra Bass clarinet, bassoon, or students that will need to use one of our school owned trombones or tenor saxes will need to pay this rental fee. ALL percussion students will pay this fee this year. This fee pays for cleaning of the instrument at the end of the year and minor dent removal. It also pays for replacing pads on woodwind instruments. The percussion fee will include replacing heads that break throughout the season and repairs on harnesses. This year the band program will charge students for any repairs that we feel are caused from neglect. The small fee we charge does not cover the entire cleaning of the equipment at the end of the year and we will no longer be responsible for paying for damage to our equipment that students cause other than minor repairs. We will check out school instruments during registration.

**Color Guard students have a separate attachment with this mailing which includes items guard students will need to pay for at registration.**

Please make sure that you have all of these items and are ready to pay for whatever you need the night of registration. Please do not show up and tell us that you have not had time to get something. We are letting you know in plenty of time to take care of these things. Also remember that the band camp fee, meal fee, sustenance fee, and water jug must be paid to *Dripping Springs Band Boosters* and the rest of the fees will be paid to *DSHS Bands*. This means that you will need to write two checks the night of registration.

## **BAND POLO SHIRTS!!!!!!**

**Informal Uniform**—Students will wear an informal uniform for the first 2 football games and informal events such as parades. The informal uniform includes the band polo shirt. We are using the same shirts as last year so only 9<sup>th</sup> graders and new students must buy a shirt. Any older student who has lost theirs or outgrown it should purchase another at registration. Sizes for polo shirts will be taken at registration night. Shirts will be purchased and picked up by students or parents from Laser Graphics (120 Frog Pond Ln. @ Hwy 290) after **August 13<sup>th</sup>**. The cost of the shirt will be approximately \$28.00. The other informal uniform parts are listed below and students must have them before the first football game on August 27<sup>th</sup>.

Informal Uniform: Band Polo Shirt, Khaki Pants (no more than 4 pockets), black belt, black socks, black band shoes

**The following are items you will need to bring with you to band camp on August 2<sup>nd</sup>.**

**What to bring:**

- Water Jug This is the one provided by the boosters.
- Instrument All students will need their instruments and mouthpieces for the camp.  
You will also need reeds, valve oil and slide grease for your instrument.
- Music Lyre To be used at camp and parents night..
- Flip Folder Everyone needs a flip folder with at least 10 pages.
- 3 Ring Binder You must have a 3 ring binder and at least 10 clear plastic pages for your music
- Clothes Please bring clothes that are comfortable to march in. We are going to camp to work, so looking great is not the most important thing to consider. Everyone should bring at least on pair of comfortable shoes to march in. Tennis shoes are fine. Sandals and boots will not be allowed to be worn during any marching rehearsals. Caps and sunglasses are fine. Please remember that we are on a school sponsored event so the dress code will be followed. Mr. Lancaster will make all decisions if a question arises about any clothing that is considered inappropriate.
- Swimsuit Be *sure* to bring one
- Alarm Clock Not absolutely necessary, but a good idea if you want to be on time.
- Bed Items Each student needs to bring a set of twin sheets, a blanket or sleeping bag, and a pillow. None of this is provided by the dorms. The temperature in the rooms varies greatly so come prepared for hot and cold.
- Lanyard This is to keep up with your room key at camp. Lost keys cost \$75.00 to replace.
- Hygiene items Bring what you need
- Towels and Washcloths
- 4 Pencils **This is required.**
- Personal Medications (Asthma, Tylenol, cold medications, ace bandages, braces, etc.)
- Bobby Pins (Freshman only)

Please do not bring a lot of extra personal property. We have a limited amount of space in the equipment trailer, and we must take our own equipment and stands.

The band boosters send out information by e-mail on a regular basis. Information about joining the boosters is included with this packet.
